## Spatial perception

### Score: 9

Spatial perception refers to a candidate's ability to find structure and regularity in shapes and sequences that follow a logical pattern. This is measured by mentally rotating figures, completing sequences, and discovering regularity in shapes. A low score could be the result of a lesser capability in this area but it could also be the consequence of carelessness.

Paul West has scored 9 on a 9 point scale which indicates that the spatial perception at higher level is very high.

## Numerical perception

### Score: 5

Numerical perception refers to a candidate's ability to have an insight in mathematical relations. An ability to calculate quickly and to recognise patterns and regularities under pressure of time is indicative of good numerical perception. A low score could be the result of a lesser capability in this area but it could also be the consequence of carelessness.

Paul West has scored 5 on a 9 point scale which indicates that the numerical perception at higher level is average.

## Linguistic perception

### Score: 8

Linguistic perception refers to a candidate's ability to understand and use language. Recognising analogies is indicative of good linguistic perception. A low score could be the result of a lesser capability in this area but it could also be the consequence of carelessness.

Paul West has scored 8 on a 9 point scale which indicates that the linguistic perception at higher level is high.

## Technical perception

### Score: 6

Technical perception refers to a candidate's ability to understand technical or physical problems. This ability is measured under time pressure.

Paul West has scored 6 on a 9 point scale which indicates that the technical perception at higher level is above average.

## Control

### Score: 6

Control measures the extent in which Paul West is capable of working fast and meticulously and performing a new task efficiently under pressure. This test indicates the level at which Paul West is able to sort, order and control. These qualities are important in administrative and technical positions. A low score in this area could be the consequence of carelessness, a slow work pace or perfectionism.

Paul West has scored 6 on a 9 point scale. This means that the score in Control at higher level is above average. Please note that 1 mistakes have been made over 48 questions answered on a total of 100 questions. This means that 47 questions have been answered correctly.

## Calculate

### Score: 6

The mathematics test consists of 39 mathematical problems with 5 alternative answers each. The mathematical problems consist of additions, subtractions, divisions and multiplications. It is important that you try to do this test as quickly as possible. The problems start off relatively easy and get progressively harder. On the one hand, the test measures your mathematical insight, on the other, your ability to cope with numbers. The result can be indicative for work that requires these skills. Precision is often paramount for such work.
